Position: Cage Cashier

Summary of DUTIES:

Cage Cashier is responsible for the smooth and efficient operation of the area to which he/she is assigned. Cashier needs to have the ability to provide uncompromising customer service to internal/external customer contacts. Ability to work in conditions of fast pace and be detailed oriented.

- Responsible for, Slot Jackpot/Fill/Credit Slips, Slot weigh and wrap verification, Soft Count/Hard Count/Vault Transfers and cash drawer verification sheets.
- Exchanges Coin and Checks for Cash.
- Ensures that all paperwork and reporting documents are well organized, legible and neat.
- Prepare and Inventory Outlet Banks when requested.
- Makes sure that all cash handling conforms to Title 31 and the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act as well as Minimum Internal Controls and Policies.
- Answer general questions about the Casino asked by customers or the general public
- Secures cash / currency to be deposited at the bank and handles transfers of funds.
- Responsible for verification of vault.
- Advises and reports to the Casino Manager, Gaming Accountant or General Manager all instances of suspected violations of department or company policy.
- All other duties as assigned
